

At Monadnock Center for Violence Prevention we are driven by the simple yet powerful belief:

Everyone in the community deserves to feel safe and needs to play a role in preventing violence.

Monadnock Center for Violence Prevention (MCVP) is the only non-profit agency in the Monadnock Region solely committed to supporting survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking, and to breaking the cycle of violence through school, community and business prevention education programs. Our advocacy philosophy is based on the empowerment model. We provide options and support survivors in their decisions.

MCVP began in 1978 as a grassroots volunteer organization known as Women's Crisis Services. In 2003, the agency's name was changed to Monadnock Center for Violence Prevention to reflect our commitment to helping women, men and children, as well as our increase in prevention education and outreach efforts. MCVP serves the 44 towns of Cheshire and western Hillsborough Counties.

CONSIDER LEAVING A LEGACY FOR MONADNOCK CENTER FOR VIOLENCE PREVENTION

It is important for all of us to plan ahead, not only so we can enjoy our older years, but so we can be taken care of when we need help and so our assets will be distributed according to our wishes after death.

As part of your planning, we hope you will consider leaving a future gift for Monadnock Center for Violence Prevention, to help us break the cycle of violence for future generations here in the Monadnock Region.

Types of Planned Gifts

The simplest way to make a planned gift is to have a provision in your **Will**. You can designate a specific amount of money or a certain percentage to MCVP.

Also, people who have a **Living Trust** or **Irrevocable Trust** can designate MCVP as the beneficiary of a specific amount or a percentage of their assets.

If you no longer need your paid-up **Life Insurance Policy**, you can designate MCVP to be the beneficiary.

A **Charitable Gift Annuity** is a contract between you and MCVP, where, in exchange for a gift such as stock, cash, or real property, we will make lifetime income payments to you and, if you choose, another beneficiary. The annual payout rate is based on the number and ages of the beneficiaries.

And a **Charitable Remainder Trust** helps you to permanently set aside funds from which you (and a second beneficiary, if you would like) receive income for life. At the time of the last beneficiary's death, MCVP would receive the funds that remain. Significant tax savings are a benefit of a charitable remainder trust.
